Turtle Trials Challenge Series!

Our technical mentors Charles, Conor and Dan G have developed a great, pre-season team training program - centered on a challenging game designed to give rookies and veterans a deep, hands-on understanding of the regular winter build and competition season - all centered around a game.

In preparation for our game challenge, our rookies and veterans built two drive chassis kits designed specifically for the game.

Fall Game Kickoff

For the Turtle Trials Challenge we staged our own mock kickoff just like the real build season. Mentors unveiled the game animation that revealed a game called "Ouick Ouota".

In the game, players will have to decide the fastest and most efficient way for their robots to deposit "particles" and "accelerators" (different sized balls) into different containers following a strict set of game rules. Alliances of 2 teams will compete for fastest completion time to reach exactly 73 points. Hopefully, this will tide over our urge to build and compete until the actual build season

in January...

Mentor Spotlight




Charles Nepomuceno
